Cloudy and sunny chilly, thawing ^{a little} considerable windy and snowing some A.M. We spread 3 or 4 loads sledged lime that has been in stable for over a year on No 1 W. north spreader in A.M. put straw on bottom and lime on top in load. P.M. I went to Mrs R. Goss sale. spent 2 ds for stamp letter to Mr. Gowen alone. also 10 ds for turnip ticket. The Girls and I were up at Tindales at night. Willie put some more paper.

Fine sunny day thawing a lot windy, mostly wheels on road now. I spread last of lime on No 1 about A.M. and load manure No 7. P.M. we spread 3 loads No 7 and brought over small load straw for pighouse floor. Willie down town and home in evening for papers etc got cocaine saltwater 5 ds

Thursday

Frosty last night. Fine sunny day thawing a lot no slips on road now. We trimmed load turnips and I took it down A.M. to chains brought up bag 5 roses from Boys or else also 2.80 lbs coal 7.76 or so. P.M. Geo Mayer helped us trim and put on a load of turnips which I took down got two tickets 20 ds got cheese from chains for the four loads 2.25 bushels \$22.50. Father & mother up for tea Mr. Lass got milk Sunday 1 qt 5
