We spread 3 or 4 loads slacked lime that has been in stable for over a year on No 1 W. with spreader in AM put straw on bottom and lime on top in load. PM. I went to Mrs A. Goss' sale spent 2 d^s for stamp letter to Mc Bowman alone. also 10 d^s for turnip ticket. The girls and I were up at Tindale's at night. Willie just now down from

Fine sunny day thawing a lot cloudy, mostly wheels on road now. I spread last of lime on No 1 about AM and load manure No 7. PM we spread 3 loads No 7 and brought over small load straw for pighouse floor. Willie down town and home in evening for papers etc got various salutes 5 d^s

Thursday

Frosty last night. Fine sunny day thawing a lot no slugs on road now. We trimmed load turnips and I took it down AM to bring back up bag 500 lbs from Boys or off also 200 lbs coal 1.50 a c^t. PM Mr Mayer helped us trim and put on a load of turnips which I took down got two tickets 20cts got change from Schaefer for the four loads 22^c bushels \$2 2.50. Father & mother up for tea Mr Goss got milk Tuesday 1 qt 5
