Cooler to-day and windy, sunny but not bright. G.S. came up in morning to tell us he had been called back to camp. we paid him in full \$9.00. M. Hill up all day raking No 7. We cut rest of No 7 in morning also some in No 3. A.M. P.M. we took in 3 loads from No 7 to other barn raking left Gordon Irvine up in evening to see about getting a job we gave him 50¢ to get meat 7 lbs for bread. Mary came up this morning.

Tuesday

Fine sunny day not very warm. M. Hill and Sunday up all day. I hauled up P.M. churning turnips. We cut rest of hay in No 3 9 M also p.m. greened potatoes. M.H. raked in No 3 P.M. we got 4 loads over to other barn from No 3 also small load raking from No 7. Mother came up to-night.

Warm sunny day moderately warm. I Irvine and Stanley up A.M. both went to church picnic P.M. M.H. up all day. We finished raking today 3 more loads from No 3 and raking of 307 also raking from T.L. fold all to other barn. Mary down town 9 M deposited Miss money sent to Dr Somerville \$335.00 expenses 40.05 sent Eaton order \$34.50 ^{sent and returned} west funding 17.05 stamps 9.05 Globe 2.05 meat Shortness 83.05 net in stals 50.05 goods at Russell's exp. \$8.87.
