- 25 Snowing. We went to call at Will Galls & took Louie & baby but they did not go in. I was poorly after we got home & did not go to choir practise.
- 26 Cold windy day. Charlie & I went to tea at the Hall & Geo came later. our organ was there & we had music & dancing.

- Jan. 27 Saturday, mild with light snowfall. I took children to Ladell's. George sold our cutter to Dick Clarke so we will have to get another.
  - 23 Stormy. I went to church at night and played the organ stormy night.
  - 29 Children are sick. Nasty weather. Cyril Thoms brought us an invitation to spend the evening there on Wednesday.
  - 30 Eva poorly still, we washed. Storming all day very heavily at night. snow will be deep in the morning.
  - 31 Cold day. I ironed. G. & I went with a sleigh load of others to Thomses in their sleigh & got home about 1 o'clock. we had a pleasant evening.
- Feb. 1 Got up late. I got cold last night & did not go to choir practise as it was very cold.
  - 2 Nice day. we did not go to Somerset's. G drove the new cutter which came today into Utterson.
  - 3 Nice day. Geo drove Charlie & W. Brymer to Falkenburg, thence they went on to Bracebridge & sold some tickets. I saw Laura & Louie at Ladells & arranged to go on Monday.
    - 4 I went to Church & played in the morning & stayed in at night. G also stayed in with headache.
    - 5 Fine & Bright & not too cold. Geo drove me & Louie to Somersets to tea. we called at Galls. Got home before ten.
    - 6 Nice fine day & moonlight night. Baby &I drove to Utterson with Geo & we waited at Will Brown/s till he was ready. Baby seems poorly tonight.
    - 7 George, Kathleen & I are all poorly today. Fine & mild.
      G. stayed in bed till tea time. Wet night.
    - 8 Wet all day. Connie Thoms is ill with slight inflammation of the lungs. Geo somewhat better. I have neuralgia in my face. No choir practise. Miss Hutton called to see if she could give up this school & go to Normal.
    - 9 Frozen up but not cold. Trustees had a meeting to see about Miss Hutton's leaving. Concert in Hall tonight in aid of Children's Hospital. I could not go as Kathleen was sick with earache etc. G. also stayed. Nice moonlight nights. Concert a success.

  - 19 Fine but cold wind. Geo & Eva & I went to Father's after dinner. Barely enough snow for sleighing.
  - 20 Lovely day. George went to Toronto. Clara walked over to stay a few days. We went to Laddells after dinner.
  - 21 Ironed & baked. Mild. Good roads. Clara & I & two children went to Ladells & found Laura Somerset there she drove us home.
  - 22 Snowing hard most of the day. The somersets came about half past 5 and spent the evening. Cyril & T. Vincent were here too. George did not come but sent a letter.
  - 23 Roads heavy. Clara did not go home. Charlie went up to Newholme with a load to a concert. George came back from Toronto.

- Feb. 24 A heavy soft snow fell all day. George & Charlie drove to Utterson.
  - 25 A cold stormy day. Clara & I ventured out to Church at night there were only a few there.
  - 26 Very cold with wind, Clara could not get home. She & I went to Ladell's after tea.

  - 8 Lovely day. Everybody turned out to enjoy the fine afternoon. Got some beef from Jenner's.
  - 9 Mild turned to snow. Charlie began to cut wood for Herb Ladell. I walked up to see Aggie who is ill.
  - 10 Fine but cold. G & I went for a drive up Utterson road. Mr. Thoms called.

  - 3 Churned. After diner I took Eva & V & Annie to Stewart's island to get berries. very dry.

  - 5 Very hot. G & I went to Church twice, Louie Thoms came home with us after morning service. We had a new clergyman.
  - 6 Hotter & no rain. 98° in the shade. Mr. Kerr came to draw wood. We had a bathe.
  - 7 Hot but we had a nice little shower this morning to lay the dust. Geo & I drove to Father's after dinner.
  - 8 Still hot, we washed. Geo had to drive Massey-H. man to Aspdin.
  - 9 George did not get home last night. Nellie &Louise Call came in the morning & went back after tea. Geo just got back to tea. he had driven the agent to Huntsville. Very hot over 90°.
  - 10 Sultry. We had a bathe, Charlie went to Dodd's party, we did not go.
  - 11 It has been a very hot week but it changed today & is blowing cool & raining. Eva & Annie went on the Gem to Huntsville. Charlie & Cyril went also & Cyril was here to tea.

- Aug. 12 Cool & turned cloudy. Felt poorly with diahorrea. I went to Church in evening. Mr. Rich preached. Louie is poorly.
  - 13 Cooler this week.
  - 14 Making Violet a Dress.
  - 15 We washed.
  - 16 Cyril Thoms was here drawing wood. Eva & I went for a row. we took Mrs. Atkinson out in the boat.
  - 17 Fine. The children & I rowed over to Thomses.
  - 18 Nice day. I went to Deerhurst & took Louie & Violet. we brough Ruth & Jessie Thoms back to tea. dusty & no rain. Aggie Laddell has a paralytic stroke.
  - 19 Louie's birthday. Mr. Rich preached twice. The childrem & I went at night. quite a crowd. Geo went over to Thomses in the afternoon. I went up to see Aggie.
  - 20 Gloomy, it rained a little this morning. No school as the new teacher has gone back home. Geo went to Crompton's to start binder. Aggie Laddel died this morning.
  - 21 Very dry. I made a wreath & took it up to Ladells & saw Aggie.
  - 22 New Williams agent called. We managed to get water enough to wash. G & I went to Miss Ladell's funeral & brought Mr. & Mrs. Thoms back to tea.
  - 23 Cloudy. Eva had a birthday party at the landing. Connie Thoms came with thechildren.
  - 24 Hot & dry. Baby and I drove to Johnson's with Mrs. Atkinson. Got home about 8.
  - 25 Hot. I took the children bathing and got caught in a thunder storm. It was a nice shower but did not last long enough to do much good. Geo and I went to Chesters in the evening. They had quite a number there. There are several of the Tye's and Puddicowns staying at Smith's & Forrests.
  - 26 Hot Sunday. G & I & children went to church in the evening. Mr. Atkinson is back.

  - 28 Miss Johnson & Mrs. Atkinson came to get us to go black berry picking we got about 10 qts. After tea I took them out for a row.

  - 30 Eva & Louie & I went to the swamp with the Forrests to get berries. I had a little drive after tea.
  - 31 We had Mr. Smith & his friends & Minnie Forrest & some of their guests & Miss( Mr. & Mrs. Vincentcame home) Rice & Mr. Chester to spend the evening.
- Sept. 1 It keeps very dusty. Geo & I went over to spend the evening at Smith's. We went bathing & when we got back we found Mr. Vincent here. C. went duck shooting got 2.
  - 2 Sunday. very hot. I went to Church in the morning & stayed home at night. Charlie went up to Galls & got the boat.
  - 3 Lovely rain this morning but cleared out nice to go on Mr. Smith's excursion to Deerhurst. We had a pleasant time.
  - 4 Bright day, we washed. Hard a row after tea &took Mrs. & Miss Rice.
  - 5 Went to W.A. meeting & brought Ruth & Cyril Thoms home to tea. Gracie & Walter Webster were also here playing with the children they made plenty of noise. I went in to Chesters in the evening with Miss Tye etc. and then went over to Forrests to see Mr. & Mrs. Mitchell who were up.

  - 12 Rain again at night turned cold & windy in the morning but we went over with all the children to Thomses. Mr. Vincent called.
  - 13 Fine but cool at night. I called at Ladell's & Atkinsons & went to choir practice.
  - 14 Finished baby's dress & made Charlie a pair of pants.
  - 15 Pleasantly warm. Annie went on the Gem to Huntsville. The Atkinsons called also Ruth Thoms. I called on the new teacher in the evening. got no partridges.

  - 21 Heavy storm last night & showery all day. I went to Church to help sweep. George was appointed to wait upon the Isolated families.

GRANDMOTHR'S DIARY ETHEL'S MARRIAGE 1900 ... 194

- Nice day. The 4 children & Charlie & I went up the Sept.22 lake in the Gem and then landed at Lawrence's and walked through to father's to leave the children there till the danger of diptheria is over. They told us of Ethel's marriage. Got home to tea.
  - 23 Cloudy but pleasant. Harvest thanksgiving service in the evening. Charlie & I walked through th Vincent's. I walked back with Nita Brymer. Cyril Thoms here to tea.
  - 24 Lovely day, we washed. I had a row after tea.
  - 25 Wet morning, but fine afternoon. Ironed. I went up to Ladells & came home and made part of a bhirt.
  - 26 Hot day. Charlie & I went to Huntsville & saw the fair. Huntsville was crowded. I saw Father, mother & Nelly. Children are all right. Mrs. Forrest & Minnie went up,
  - 27 Katy Lever came & made annie a waist. Mr. Robinson was here to dinner.
  - 28 Katy made me a wrapper. Cold night but wet next morn. Charlie went to the Presby tea meeting.
  - 29 Rain all the morning. Geo shipped Straw-cutter. Lovely afternoon. I have a bad cold.
  - 30 Sunday. Nice day. I went to church twice. Had a walk.
- Oct. 1 Fine. Geo & Charlie went for cow. We cleaned two rooms & finished upstairs. Mr. & Mrs. Huggins & Mr. & Mrs. Stevenson came to see Geo & had to wait till about 7 before he came, they had tea here. Miss O'Brian & Louie Forrest called. We heard that Vincent's have diptheria & possibly Mabel Clarke.
  - 2 G. drove me to Father's where I will stay for a while with thechildren. Mother is no better. Hares girls were there.
  - 3 I ironed the children's clothes. I took the children to Armstrongs & Fanny made us stay to tea. Claza went to Huntsville.
  - 4 This is a very hot fine week, over 80° every day.

- Oct. 5 I washed for the children. Geo drove over & baby & I went to Huntsville with him. I got some medicine for Mother.
  - 6 87° in the shade, we sat under the trees. Mother is not better.
  - 7 Heavy rain & thunder storm made it quite cold. Took the children to Church in the evening. I played the organ.
  - 8 Cold but fine. The children & I went to Hares & had tea. Willie Bray & family were at father's when we got back.
  - 9 Nice day. Eva & I drove to Hville to see Dr. Evans.
  - 10 Lovely day. Geo came & took Kathleen & me home. Lucy & Mother drove to Hville. Minnie Forrest called to see me about going to Dodds. Cyril Thoms came in the evening.
  - 11 Foggy mornings & fine days. Charlie's birthday. Are 17 Geo rowed Mrs. & Minnie Forrest & me to Dollar's Wharf & we walked to Dodds where we spent the day & Tom drove us home. M. Forrest & I went to meeting in vestry. Geo brought the children home.
  - 12 Lovely day making Louie a dress. Geo went to Longhurst's. he & I went to Forrests to tea, home late.
  - 13 Beautiful day after the fog. I went to Ladell's & finished L's dress.
  - 14 Still fine & mild. I went to Church twice.
  - 15 Warm & fine. The Dodds & Forrests came to tea. The Chesters & Mr. S. Smith came in the evening & we had music. The Somersets could not come.
  - 16 Rain & high wind turned very cold. Busy sewing.
  - 17 Washed, fine & pleasant. hard frost at night.
  - 18 Went up to the Hall to prepare for the Supper tonight as it is Thanksgiving day. Will Johnson came to tea. We went to Church & then to the hall where quite a crowd gathered & enjoyed turkey etc. Cold windy night
  - 19 Nice day. The Forrests & I went to the Hall & washed up. I drove to Ladell's in afternoon.
  - 20 Beautiful weather. Went for a short drive, Will Johnson came & took his horse away.

- Oct. 21 Lovely day. Took thechildren for a walk. I did not go to church.
  - 22 Like rain but it kept off till night. We had Laura & Mr. Somerset & Jessie, Louie & Cyril Thoms to tea & Henry Gall came with invitations to a dance on Friday and he stayed the evening.
  - 23 Heavy rain in the morning, we washed & caught a lot of water. G & Louie & I went trolling after dinner but caught nothing. Keeps mild.
  - 24 Cloudy but cleared off in afternoon. Geo went to a sale near Raymond. Children did not go to school,
  - 25 We cleaned sitting room.
  - 26 Washed bedding. Geo went to Dodds by lake. Warm. Heavy rain & thunder in the afternoon & again in the evening. Henry Gall was here to tea. His dance came off in the Hall. I did not go on account of the rain.
  - 27 Sunday. Cloudy & mild. Minnie Forrest & I rowed over to Thomses with the children & were prevailed upon to stay to tea. G & I & 2 children went to church at night.
  - 28 Came on rain which continued till night so we did not go to Galls. blowing at night. Cleaned dining room.
  - 30 Gloomy & Cold. The children walked to Bob Brown's, Geo & I drove to Gall's. The Somersets were there, a dark drive home.
  - 31 Hallow eve. Charlie finished at the mill. I went to spend the evening at Chester's.
- Nov. 1st Our hunterswere out early. They are hunting with Mr. Vincent & Cyril, no luck.
  - 2 Hunting again. got nothing.

- 3 They went up to C. Mainhoods hunting no success. Cyril usually comes here to tea. Henry & Louise Gall came & washed the dishes here that were left from the party.
- 4 Lovely morning. I went to SS in the afternoon and took all the children. I took Louie to let Mr. Erymer see her eye which is no better. G & E & C & I went to Church - Charlie went to Thomses in the afternoon.
- 5 Fine morn. we washed. We had the first snow storm today. Hunters got nothing. Got 2 bags of flour.

- Nov. 7 Ethel and Mabel came before dinner. I rode up to Ladell's with them. No W.A. meeting. Our hunters came back to dinner.
  - 8 The men want to hunt at Bob Brown's and got a deer which they left there. We expected Mrs. & Louise Gall but they did not come.
  - 9 High cold wind. G did not go out.
  - 10 Cloudy & raw. G & C & Mr. Vincent went up to Brown's but got nothing. D. Stevenson came & I sold him a sewing machine. Mr. Allman is up to attend Lodge meeting.
  - 11 Gloomy. G & I & children went to church. Mr. & Miss Johnson came while we were at dinner. Went to Church at night.
  - 12 Began to snow. We washed. hunters came back early with nothing. Cold night.
  - 13 Snow all day. 6 below zero at night.
  - 14 Charlie went hunting. G did not. Nice morning but stormed all afternoon & all night. Cyril Thoms drove us and a sewing machine to D. Stevenson's. E. Johnson & the two girls & G & I went and had an awful trip.
  - 15 Nearly 2 feet of snow this morning. Fine & cold, Louie & Connie Thoms & May & Cyril called. E. Johnson & I drove to Forrests in the cutter & had tea. The roads are not bad in the village.
  - 16 Nice fine day. Miss Johnson & I & the little ones went to Ladell's & called at the parsonage. Killed the pigs.
  - 17 Mild & gloomy. Geo drove to Huntsville. Miss J. & the thildren called at Brymers.
  - 18 Wet roads very sloppy. We ventured out to Church in the evening. Very few there.
  - 19 Wet day & freezing as it rained. I had letters from Connie & Muriel.
  - 20 Foggy &mild. Geo went to Bracebridge on the Jury. Miss Johnson & I rowed over to Thomses and Wall & Cyril brought us back. Charlie is working at a scow.
  - 21 Had a thunder storm in the morn and very heavy rain. Then a high wind and a sprinkle of snow at night. George came home. we washed.

- Nov. 22 We had to dry all the clothes indoors. Connie & Ruth Thoms & Minnie & Louie Forrest & Miss O'Brien came to tea it turned wet and we kept Connie & Ruth all night.
  - 23 Dick came over for his sisters in the morn & Connie went home & Ruth stayed and went with Edie to Brymers to tea & then went home with Wall who was there.
  - 24 The snow has almost disappeared and the roads are frozen had. Geo drove in to Utterson. Miss Johnson Violet and I walked to Ladell's & got some things.
  - 25 Miss J. & Violet & Annie went to Church in the morn and She & I and Geo & the children went at night. cold and dark. We had a walk in the afternoon and called at Forrests.
  - 26 Cold wind but good dry roads. George drove E. Johnson home after dinner. Children went to school. G. went to Trustee's meeting this evening. windy.
  - 27 Fine day. We washed and dried most of the clothes out doors.
  - 28 Ironed. Charlie Gardiner was thrown off a wagon by a runaway team into the river and drowned.
  - 29 Men were searching for little boy's body in the river and found it this morning. Nita Brymer & Mable Clarke called to collect for a subscription to pay for Charlie Gardiner's coffin.
  - 30 Ground is still almost bare & frozen. Charlie and I went to service and practice. Annie went up to McInnis' to stay till Sunday.
- Dec. 1 Still mild. Eva is poorly with billious headache. Jack & Dick Thoms came to go hunting with Charlie. Charlie Gardiner was buried. G. went to funeral.
  - 2 Sunday. Cloudy but mild. Eva not much better. G & C. & I went to evening service.
  - 3 Eva is a good deal better. Gloomy but not cold. Mr. Patterson brought a load of hay. Maud Brymer called in evening.
  - 4 We washed. It came on wet. Geo went to McCanenses(?) I bought some lamb from Alfred Kay.

- Dec. 5 Brought the clothes into dry. Fine. sloppy roads I went to W.A. meeting & brought Louie & Ruth Thoms to tea. They and the children went to practice in evening.
  - 6 G & C went to hunt saw nothing.
  - 7 Lovely moonlight night. G & I drove to Utterson I made Xmas cake.
  - 8 Nice day. Geo drove to Council meeting. Charlie spent the day at Thomses. hardly enough snow for sleighing.
  - 9 Very cold wind. G & C & I went to Church at night.
  - 10 Not so cold a little snow fell.
  - 11 Fine day. We washed & baked. Mr. Somerset came for sewing machine and George drove me to Somersets to show Laura how to run the machine. We found all the Vincents there, we stayed to tea and got home about 10.
  - 12 Snowy all day. choir practice at night. Geo did not go to Falkenburg.
  - 13 I made mincemeat.
  - 14 good sleighing now.
  - 15 Violet & I went to Ladells & called at the parsonage.
  - 16 Bright & sharp. I had a walk in the morning. Mrs. Johnson and Will drove over in the afternoon & stayed to tea. G & I went to Church in the evening.
  - 17 Raw but not so cold. Lucy & Ethel drove over & bought Chesters cutter from us. The Atkinsons came to tea.
  - 18 Mild & snowing at intervals. George & Charlie drove to Eracebridge & got somethings at Hays on the way. We washed.
  - 19 Made the Xmas puddings.
  - 20 There were decorations made for Church. Cyril Thoms was here to tea. I went to the Church for a short time after tea. School closed today. Miss O'Brien & Ida Jenner called, also Sophia Kershaw & Billie.
  - 21 George went to Ufford to see Mr. Oldham.
  - 22 Lovely mild day. I went for a drive to Tom Howards.

- Dec. 23 Sunday, came on wet. G & I went to Church at night.
  - 24 A little snow fell. George went to Raymond and sold Miss Sufferin a sewing machine. Charlie helped Mr. Vincent at his shooting match at Utterson. They finished decorating church. I went up to Ladell's English letters.
  - 25 Christmas day. Some of the children & I went to Church. quite stormy afternoon and dull enough. Willie & Walter Brymer here to tea.
  - 26 We washed. Nellie & Clara came before dinner. Bright & cold. We all but George went to our Xmas tree in the evening.
  - 27 Milder with a little snow. Geo drove Nellie & Clara part of the way home. Expected the Vincents but they did not come.
  - 28 Nice day. The Children & I went to Pres. Xmas tree which was very good. quite a crowd.
  - 29 Softer again. Mr. Lawrence came & paid a note for \$15. Cheese factory meeting here. Mrs. Hares came & had tea here and also some of the directors as the meeting was prolonged late. Charlie cutting wood at Nackasons.
  - 30 Sunday. Flurries of snow. George went to Thomses & came back with them to Church. Duncan, Minnie & Mabel Forrest came to tea. I went to church with them afterwards.
  - 31 A little snow fell. We washed. Geo went to Utterson to Nomination. Charlie went to a dance at Ladell's.
