Very warm sunny day. Mr Bass here all day finished last row of turnips and had corn I scuffled corn twice to one row to get close up to corn. Willie down town in AM with Kate to Prince Alexander he got meat 30 lbs green beans at Morris 75 we just paid green beans on potatoes in PM then we got out side d. rake and Willie raked turnips out yesterday. Willie drove me down to meeting of managers in evening. Mother up in PM

Willie down town in AM got at Armstrong's grocer 82 sold eggs 2. 1/2 lbs basket chairs up meat 50 lbs We got in the 7 line hay today 3 1/2 loads with rakes bound with badder. Willie up at Don Daniels with Nellie in evening. Paid Mr Bunting in full \$150
