I was at prayer meeting it is beautiful at night for the youngsters, fine ice, moon near the full, and every boy and girl who can get a pair of skates, is on the ice
- 6 Woman's meeting at Lindgers I was there. gave 50 cts 15 percent besides Mrs. Sinder, done a good deal work. The wind is cold, roads icky, would be better of snow. Pa feels very poorly today -50
- 7 Another fine day, no snow yet. Skating splendid, had a letter from Jimmie, he is sick has quinsy
- 8 Alick Collett paid \$3.<sup>00</sup> of rent  
Marion and I went across the fields to Tom Henon's swamp and got cedar & hemlock  
got at Willie's butter 1.<sup>00</sup> Aunt got codfish 30. bra 1 - 25  
25. Coal oil 1 galt 25. Black strap 25-1.05 25
- 9 This has been a beautiful day, Hatty came, and has gone to skate with Birdie
- 9 Very fine day no preaching in our church  
Given is at Lunenburg, Hatty is here yet  
Cousin Domic & wife were here. So was uncle Hugh and Aunt Flora
