Sunny and cloudy AM started to rain about 3 PM rained exceedingly heavy again streams of water running. Mr Valley here in auto in morning tested samples of top and subsoils of No 5 near S.S. said it lacked available phosphoric acid also iron also lacked humus. Willie took cream to Russell's took 12 doz eggs to 70s @ 23cts \$2.76 got turnip seed \$1.18 3 lbs oatmeal 25cts got at Shortlands steak 45cts lard 35cts at Chapmans hinges etc for manure spreader 25cts got at Mannies 125 nails 35cts staples 25 he brought up 7 & M We plowed some in No 1 AM PM fixed manure spreader worked at movable pig pen plowed to run water to creek top of No 5. Edith Allan came PM stayed all night. Willie drove 7 & M down after the rain. Bella still down preparing.
