1 gall coal oil 20. matches 5 - soda 5 - 2 loaves 14 - 44
- 10 a shower last night. and a shower night before of my Maggie in London must come on 11th
- 11 Jean came by A.M. train remained all day
- 12 2 loaves 14 - 1 doz cookies 10 - 1 doz buns 10 - Milk 42 0 - 76
- 13 Communion, I was not there, sent \$2.00 for Misses 25 2 25
- 14 Ann 65 - Pease 15. Bull dogs picture 15 95
- 15 Rain all day
- 16 Had boys planting corn
- 17 3 loaves
- 19 2 lbs butter 70 coal oil 20. 1 lb cookies 10 1-00

- 20 Sunday Church off 25.
- 21 Jimmie left for Hamilton this A.M. Bus of Scot meeting. I put in a few cucumber seed
- 22 Sold 3 doz eggs at Mr Kimmons 20^{cts} per do
To 2 loaves at Dunlop 12. Fine and cool
Mrs J. W. Ferguson and Maggie called last evening
This is a fine cool day
