 on R.B. #1145 \$1.50 S. Cup all day Donald  
 up PM both got tea here the thrashers  
 only got dinner. Willie drove mother  
 down to day PM got bread 14 cts postage  
 stamps 10 got at Chapman's elbow for mother  
 she paid him 20 cts also 20 cts for me he got sometime  
 ago he owes her 5 cts he paid J. Chapman in full  
 for Deering binder <sup>also gasoline 1.30</sup> check on A.B. #36.30 also  
 gave check for \$4.00 to Wm Dix for Beath  
 Bros water <sup>buckets</sup> <sup>Wm. with young Bolson trying</sup> note to get hands to go to his thrashing. <sup>(got 2 cars)</sup> Early & H. Black  
 J. H. Dix died to-night
