of grain to get chopt in the fore noon. after
noon I attended the quarterly meeting. the boys
were husking

Tue Nov 6th cloudy and cool. John and I were
husking. Walter was plowing

Walter finished plowing the field he was at
after noon he and John was to pad. Zecks
husking bee. I was husking most of the day.

Thu Nov 8th cloudy and wet. raining hard while I am
writing Walter and I was picking over some

Fri Nov 9th cloudy and some rain heavy rain last
night we were picking apples in the fore noon. I was
husking corn the after noon Walter banking
the cow stable

Sat Nov 10th cloudy and some rain. I we were
repairing the pig pen floor and putting up
some pigs to fatten. and repairing fence.

Sun Nov 11th cloudy fore noon clear after noon

Mon Nov 12th fore noon cloudy. after noon clear and
mild we were all husking in the fore noon
Walter and Richard were drawing in corn
in the after noon
