- 7 Jimmie Karpald's daughter & son called here today. They both look well. They live in Chereya. To 3 lbs steak 30. Rev Langel of Martintown preached. Pabbie Demoula began to paint the eaves of the house
- 8 Sunday, a large congregation. Very fine day. Aunt Mary and Mary were here to dinner. Collected for St. M. P. as off 4.00
- 9 Murdy left early for North. Demoula here today. Jimmie cut a good many limbs off the trees along Wellington St.

- 15 Lovely day. A large congregation. He saw Libby McLaman for a short time. She is to leave Friday for China, she is going as a teacher, to Hunan
- 16 Demoula 1/2 day. Mrs Taylor died at 4.20 P. M.
- 17 Murdy went North to be gone until Friday. Just got home from the meeting at West Zabeth. The church was crowded to the door. Mr Matheson presided. Had his choir, two solos. Miss Fraser Lunenburg. Miss McLaman. Mrs Fraser in behalf of her meeting of the W. F. M. I presented Libby with a book and a purse of \$5. 11.30 P. M. One dollar to the purse 1.00
- 18 Mrs Taylor buried, aged 67. Began to rain about 3 P. M. Rained until midnight. To 2 1/2 lb sausage 25, To 1 lb tea 25 50. 2 1/2 yds flannel 25 Spices turpentine 13 38
- 19 Demoula all day. Doing some cleaning
- 20 Rain Demoula 1/2 day. I was cleaning up stairs. Murdy came at 7 P. M. storming
- 21 Very high wind. No fog
- 22 Cold raw
