- 11 Ad & Henry drawing wood
- 12 Do Do Do Do
- rain 13 heavy rain last night & most of the day snow nearly all gone the Boys ground an upst are & chapel wood at the house in the wood shed the ground in a shape
- 14 cut wood at the house
- 15 Rev. Mr Dunlap preached at 3 o'clock ^{the morning} in meeting in
- snowed 16 Snowed about 2 inches last night misty snow & rain this morning a cow had a lamb last night
- 17 Ad & Henry went to the 9th concession this morning I went with them with the waggon as far as the woods north of Gadies Thomas Bradley took some traps on his slough then the slaughtering in the woods they are going to put up a pen with it in five days
