- 7 drew in the potatoes from crates had about 80
bushel considerable of them rotten
- 8 the Boys drew in 4 load of turnips to a pit
in the garden I worked at the cider press &
grinders with Jack & Rab. fine day
- 9 made cider for ourselves. Rab. J. Quensery
& Wick's & J. Tennent then is over 50
Bushel in the Cheese the Boys drew
2 loads of turnips into another ^{the garden} pit in
heavy rain most of the day
- 10 the Rev. Mr. Bronsberg preached in Caintown
- 11 made 6 teeth for the thrashing machine
- 12 the Boys drew in the last of the turnips
into the garden we have over 500 Bushel
in the forenoon thrash out for Jack
- 13 went to John Young's got my boots fixed & Cleo
Chas looked at Ruleses horses
- 14 came home looked at horses at Gitalands
in Plumhalow paid Adoin. Brinston
3 that I owe for leather & bought half a cyp
- 15 the Boys drew wood from crates & lit water
- 16 plowed front of Ebenezer in forenoon then
- 17 finished plowing front of house
