18th I tried to go to Lancaster went as far as
Sussex Island the ice taken from there to
shore turned back from there East Wind
shipped about a Pail of Water change
in the noon to night turned stormy with snow
wind changed to the West through the night
15th Sunday Drifting windy 20th Hanning ice
breaking along shore 21st crossed with 4 Bushels of Wheat
left it with John Hamilton to take to Mill took the
Hole to A J Baker 55 lbs took a few Onions to Walter
Baker a fine day wind caused from the East
burying old John McPherson to day heard Walter
Died and heard so Fisher died sent a letter and paper
to Charles 56 Market Street Birkenhead Chesue 22nd
wind changed to the West to night a Terrible Gale
from the Big Elm tree up in the swamp made

and I gathered 9 hauls a fine day sap running 11th Georges
Wife making sugar to day 12th put out my little
canoe tried for Eels got 1 ice going down Gordon
and Pete cropped 13th went down to fish Eels got
George took home his share of the Sugar
14th Made mollasses to day shot a Rat 15th
a fortunate day High East Wind did not come
to the Bush to day very unwell to day in
Bed 16th a fortunate day took the Boat
down out of the Barn to the shore tried it
it Leaks Bad Set 3 traps Macell mollasses
to day kind of sour took home their Barrel and
the cow trying hard to go to the Bush good
of the island
