- 16 Cold, very like winter
- 17 Nothing new. Do 2 1/2 lbs steak 25¢. Pa got the meat cutter on Monday 1.50.
- 18 Very cold ice on the river
- 19 Skating on the river
- 21 Cold. The ice is good our girls did not go to the river yet. Murdy was at school this week, Jimmie was at Glen Donald the middle of the week
- 21. Cold not many in church roads rough
- 22. Bright day I washed. 1/2 gill coal oil 18 box matches 10 called at G. A's in evening. Mrs Shaw was there
- 23. Jimmie put in wood in cellar 1/2 13 1/2 lb beef from M. Kewin. 81 cts. I put it through the cutter. made collops. Birdie was washing her cravenott dress. Pa & Jimmie went to Lancaster to see Edwin McLennan who is visiting his old home
- 24 Mary Roy was here last night. The end Birdie went to the Glen to see the binoculars killed the goose, sold Monday. to Donahue Cornwall for \$30. Got tin today
- 25 Thanksgiving day, had preaching not many out snow fell about 9 a.m. turned to rain Peckle Sharp has a party tonight not a pleasant evening
- 26 Rain and drizzle all day. Uncle Donald & Fur were here they brought a small cheese about 42 lb
- 27 Done our usual Saturday work, baked in oven
- 28. Sunday Cold but bright. Temperance sermon Mr Given preached from Isaiah 28 chapt. from 14 to 22 verses, a splendid address
- 29 Done the washing. Very fine day
- 30 St Andrews day. Fine day, nothing going on to celebrate St. A. Birdie & Jimmie went to Martintown to a concert the S of S. are making. 1/2 10 lbs beef

- 1 Wednesday. Began to snow about 6.30 a.m. snowed all day
- 2 W. F. M. P met at the manse for the annual meeting appointed officers, no changes, but in the president, Mrs. S. Symons, for 1894
- 3. To 10 lbs stew 30 cts High concert tonight
- 4 Rain and frost Old Adolphus fell dead
- 5. Rain. A Mr. Hear from Avonmore preached. Mr Given was at burnmore
- 6. Slipping ice all over. The Old Adolphus was buried today. He went with his son Alick to get wood at Mary George's place and fell dead. He was said to be 87 years old. Married 65 years
- 7 Snowing all day. Murdy went to Cornwall as a furr 1/2 9 lbs beef 50 cts. 100 flour 2.80, not paid
- 8. Very fine day, mild, moon full tonight
- 9. Turned soft. Edwin McLennan came to visit Kate.
- 10. Uncle Donald and Mary were over. They brought us a bunch strip of pork from back to belly. Edwin McLennan spent the afternoon and evening here. 1/2 salt corn 10¢. Salt fine 10¢
- 1/2 B. tea 25. 1.50 just stamps
- 11. Began to rain about 6. a.m. showered and drizzled all day. had a letter from Fur Jimmie drove E. McLennan, to Lower Lancaster, 4 P.M.
- 12 Dull day (no snow rain or frost) not many in church
- 13 Rain all day
- 14 Fine dull day Made the washing, did not hang it out
- 15 Rain. Abrams. came and paid Pa \$20.00 Pa paid Aunt Kate what she borrowed of her. and paid Willie 2.80 for bag flour
