Grober emphasizes the importance of stimulating the heart action, relieving it of some of its task by venesection in case of the full blooded, and by revulsion. Expectorants and narcotics are seldom needed, as there is already sufficient impulse to cough, and the usual accumulation of carbon dioxide in the blood has a narcotic action. These may fail, however, and each case should be studied individually.—*Deutsch. Med. Woch.*
