Warts.

Cates cures warts by means of ethyl chloride, leaving no scar. By coagulating the blood in the vessels supplying the wart nutrition is shut off, and it consequently shrivels and drops off. The skin bevond the margin of the wart should be protected by a pledget of sterile cotton, wet in cold water, drawn out in tape form, and then wrapped around the wart. A fine stream of ethyl chloride is played over the wart until it is covered with frost. One or two applications will make most warts disappear. Moles and angiomas may be treated in a similar way.—Amer. Pract.
