4 all worked at floor except Thannie he drew 2 loads
 of wood from his father he lent it to us the roads is in
 a very bad state they are almost impossible

5 Ad went to granagee for the doors windows and
 some flooring plank for the kitchen Thannie got one of
 his Fellows horse to draw some wood to the road the Thannie
 horse is sick and has sprained her leg hand frost last night

6 Ad & Wallace brought out the doors plank & sashes
 and finish the floor Thannie cleaned out the cellar

7 Thannie helped to draw stones & gravel to the shed
 at the church there was 4 teams & hands to keep them going
 got a good job done Ad & me worked at the kitchen

James W. Mullen took M. Stewart to Fairfax had frost
 it is snowing this morning Ad & Wallace come out &
 they & Thannie drew dung into the garden it was
 the heaps that was shoveled up or gathered up in the open

10 rain and snow most of of the day Thannie
 drew a few loads of dung we worked at the kitchen
 in the afternoon he quit working to day

11 Ad & me worked in the kitchen we hung the south
 door and fitted the north one heavy rain last
 night the snow is all gone this morning rain & snow
 with wind

12 Malcom Cowan came for to work he has hired him for
 a year for twelve dollars a month that is 144 dollars

he drew dung to the garden he took all the heaps with
 you

13 Malcom cut up the oak logs that the wind blew down
 and cut up whatever else was because he got sure to have
 it

14 Malcom drew wood for them at the road & cut wood for
 Sunday here to day we hung the north door had frost
