Fri June 21 fore noon clear and hot. I went to Florence and deposited some money in the Post office bank. after noon cloudy, not doing much.

Sat June 22 cloudy and hot. was working in the garden part of the day

Sun June 23 light clouds and warm

Mon June 24 clear and hot. 90 deg in the shade. I hoed the corn in the garden

Tue June 25 cloudy most of the day. about as yesterday for heat. I hoeing potatoes and killing bugs

Wed June 26 clear and hot. not doing much to day 93 deg in shade

Thu June 27 clear and hot and hotter still 98 deg in shade at 3.30 p m not doing any thing to day. to hot

Fri June 28 clear and hot. I was down to the old place doing a little hoeing

Sat June 29 clear with strong wind from South West. not doing much

Sun June 30 clear and hot

Broton July 1901

Mon Jul 1 clear and hottest a can remember 105 deg in the shade. I hoed in the garden part of the fore noon. not doing much the rest of the day.

Tue Jul 2 clear and not quite as hot as yesterday. I cutt weeds on the road doing part of my Statute labour and paris greened potatoes

Wed Jul 3 cloudy fore part of the day and hot was cutting weeds on the road in the road in the fore noon. after noon went to see James Ward buried the corpse didnt get to the ground as expected I came away

Thu Jul 4 cloudy and hot. I was doing my Statute labour

Fri July 5 cloudy and hot a fine rain last night and this morning I was ribing sprouts of potatoes

Sat Jul 6 light clouds high wind from the West and warm. I went to Florence this fore noon with Mr Newcomb not doing much the rest of the day
