 to night They went up on the Monument
 some Rain to night and today Helen crossed to go off
 Leander and Minnie with her a very wet time with
 showers 102 of them Big Steamers passed down today
 to 1 Pair of Ducks 50 to Eddy for do Douggett The Websters
 to Butter 1 lb 20 3 doz of Eggs 36 pint of Cream 12 1/2 Thunder
 ice 10 chickens 30 picked 18 Helen stop at Hamiltons
 to night a Fortunate Day 11th a Fortunate Day
 Sunday Helen started for Home Took
 3 of Mr Barnharts children with her heavy
 Rain Thunder and Lightning Yesterday afternoon
 one of them Big vessels went up to day
 Fine to day 12th Fine Day Turning the Wheat
 and oats a Mr Stevenson called here for an
 oar as he Broke his. gave him one he is
 from Stanley Island split some cedar rails
 Leander crossed to night Bought Bread 13th Very
 Fine Day Made 1 Stack of Wheat commenced another
 gathering Wheat got 7 sturgeon this Morning Leander
 crossed took over ice Mrs Dan Frasher and
 2 of Evans girls Jennie Sarah Ellen Boring
 us a Lot of Good apples Ed Kershaw
 got 4 doz of Eggs 48 paid B bought a Lot
 of Cucumbers Jessie came down

 Mr Lotman here for ice for the Websters 10 cents not paid
 The Fillgate a Party on her pass down very very warm
 today New Moon comes in this Morning Made a
 Stack of oats 4 Loads in it a Mr Hall here for Butter
 to 5 lb of Butter 1 dollar Penny Mrs Intyre Biala Cameron
 Intyre Daisy came Adelaide Jessie Lily here for Butter
 25 cents worth 15th Fine warm Smoky Unfortunate Day
 Leander took Mrs M^c Intyre and Burton to Lancaster
 where they will meet Mrs Intyre one of Lewis Boys
 here for Butter and Salt 27 cents Went up to the Head of
 the Island Met with a Gentleman his wife and
 Daughter a Mr Creighton was his name
 from Ottawa Being at one time a Pupil
 of Dan's cutting the oats at the East side of the
 Lane Rained some and Smoky Assumption Day
 Leander and the 2 Girls crossed to Summers town 16th Fine
 some Wind Mowing the Oats Peter Back here to Bread
 crossed Leander for the Papers 17th Made a Stack of
 Oats 4 Loads in it very Fine Day Adelaide and
 Miss Annan and Jessie came down a Letter from
 John Cameron Kansas City Junction Daisy gang
 across this Evening as they are to meet her
 in Summers town to Morrow Mr McIntyre
 Websters to chickens 30 ice 25 cream 10 Mr. Munton
 took 3 lb of Butter 60 corn 10, 18th Sunday Leander to church
 Mr Mac Intyre came to Summers town for Daisy
 A Mr Williams Preached in Salem Church today a
 Social or Pic. Nic at Hopkins Point today a
 2 Steamers the Chaffy from Lancaster with
 a crowd and the Paul Smith from Valley field
 Paul Smith Gray and 2 more here got The
 Little Island North Side from Paul Gray and
 he got it from chief White Tooth his Father in law
 one of the cows calved
