- 5 " 1 lb corn starch 10. 3 lbs molasses 15- 23
- 6 4 loaves 24 4 1/2 lbs steak charged a Mr Indigo 24
- 7 Mrs Doest a registered letter with 4.50 for interest
- 8 Preaching in afternoon by Rev Tate. I paid stipend 1.50 + 1.50
- 9 4 loaves 24. Jimmie went to J P got the syrup
- 10 Raining all day
- 11 High wind very destructive up west- 60
- 12 To butter 43. 5 loaves 30 Ice all off the river 73 55
- 13 butter 64 1 gall coal oil. began to snow 17
- 14 This is a very fine day. It is the anniversary of my marriage ^{mine & Thomas' & one two daughters} To currants 3 lbs 25- 25
- 15 nutmeg 25 rolled oats 25- Murdy a fine roast 30 0
- 16 Very fine day Sunday off 50 50 5-
- 17 D. M Crummon gave me a cheque on M. Bank for \$ 20⁰⁰ on Saturday 10
- 18 Fine warm day. I bottled the syrup today Alick M Cullach died Sunday evening by his own hand To 9 1/2 yds wadding 20
- 19 Marion put up a quilt in bedroom down stairs turned in one strip on the side To 2 lbs butter 50
- 20 Hard frost last night Mrs A C M Donald called. Alick M Cullach buried today 8
- 21 Very fine. Jimmie left early in morning. got home at 10.30 a.m. had a pithe. had a gun 10
- 22 Began to take milk from Cathine 5^{cts} per quart to get tomorrow for first 18
- 23 Not many in church off 10- 5-
- 24 Marion washed
- 25 J Lavidette paid 2 for rent paid it to Jimmie
- 26 To 100 flour 3.30 1/2 bush potatoes 5 loaves 30 4-60
- 27 To 2 lbs butter 60 1 gall coal oil 20 70
