20<sup>th</sup> per rod for post. & 25<sup>¢</sup> per rod for the rest  
20<sup>th</sup> Finished sowing turnips W. slow rain from  
about 10 A.M. to 3 P.M.  
21<sup>st</sup> I & W worked on road in Markham Drove gravel  
22<sup>nd</sup> I & W finished road work, & drew some rails  
this evening. W. fine clear, looks a little like rain tonight  
23<sup>rd</sup> I & W repaired some fences & David finished  
harrowing fallow A.M. I & Nancy went to  
Markham P.M. W. fine clear  
24<sup>th</sup> Made Vinegar & ground Mower knives  
A.M. I took Cent to Caldwell the B Smith  
in Whitevale to get shot P.M. W. fine rain  
last night & awhile A.M. Clear P.M.  
Monday 25<sup>th</sup> Went to Meeting at Hebron remarks  
by B<sup>r</sup> C. Sermon on Acts 10<sup>th</sup> C by Rev H Barker  
J.D. were here after service & A.B.'s & Fairbanks  
youngster's at supper. W. fine clear  
26<sup>th</sup> I moved about 5<sup>th</sup> acres in big field north of old bush  
27<sup>th</sup> I brought 500 tiles from Pettys A.M. boys shook  
up hay, raked part & began to cook P.M. began thunder  
shower about 3 P.M. splendid rain & went to Cedar Grove  
this evening

28<sup>th</sup> Drove some <sup>just</sup> wood 16<sup>th</sup> Choked <sup>very</sup> A.M. began  
to shake out hay at 3 P.M. raked & cocked  
after supper didn't get quite all cocked. W  
29<sup>th</sup> W worked on road in Scarborough I cocked  
a little hay then went to J.D.'s raising A.M.  
helped Old W.M. put up a few cocks of  
hay he made Clover on Scarborough side on  
Shores W. fine cool clear  
30<sup>th</sup> Fixed Wagon rack & drew 1 load of hay out of  
Scarboro Meadow A.M. drew 1 load out of Scarborough  
into new barn & left it standing on wagon to  
take to J. Burkholder tomorrow & drew in 2  
loads north of old bush P.M. I went to job hitting  
on 11<sup>th</sup> Con this evening Set it to M.D. Kes  
at 28<sup>¢</sup> per rod Clearing out ditches &  
grading road to be performed on or before  
10<sup>th</sup> Sept the rest. W. fine clear cool sharp  
July 1<sup>st</sup> Dominion day Stacked the rest of my  
about 4 loads had R.W. & Steele to help A.M.  
W took that load to J.B. & I raked over the  
meadow P.M. I & little boys went fishing  
awhile this evening little John could not go  
his foot is sore yet W. fine. Cool. Clear  
Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> at home all day Nancy went to meeting  
at Cobers. & Adeline went to meeting at  
Wideman with B<sup>r</sup> C's W. fine clear warm  
3<sup>rd</sup> I & W drew in 1 load rappings & filled in drains  
with Plow A.M. I began to mow in field near Hoover's  
P.M. W. fine. warm clear  
4<sup>th</sup> Choked A.M. I went to Cedar Grove P.M. & mowed after  
supper. W. fine rain A.M.
