 brought back 20 or 25 bushes frozen ones

Cloudy day not very frosty. We
 took down two loads turnips to-day
 Mary down in P.M. got tooth in at Reid's
 she got borax 5. Mother up in P.M.

Friday

Not frosty to-day, cloudy, dense
 snow falls at times through day.
 We took down two more loads turnips
 to-day. Bought 2 gals coal oil from Curliss⁴⁰
 Wm. Brown and Jim Mills in in P.M.
 bought 'May' heifer @ 4 1/4 per cwt go away
 to-morrow received on her \$5.00. weighing turnips⁵⁰
 Bella called on Mrs. Dunn in P.M. and
 both B & M. on Mrs. Hay in evening
 Dave Allan got lend of hay rack to get hay
 from Singus.
