- 4 Lovely day large congregation John and Agnes were down Church off 50.⁰⁰
- 5 Ann Hall 30.⁰⁰ Mrs Christie and Katie here to tea 2 loaves 14. They brought me wild grapes
- 7 Another fine day W. H. M met in vestry a good meeting My off 50.⁰⁰ subscription for missionary book 25. fine 10. tea fund 5
- 8 Dull day drizzle in evening Mrs Govin sent me a nice loaf of bread
- 9 This is Field day for the schools
- 10 Milk 35 Killed two cocks ^{gave me people} Ann plucked 1. The other Monday will be Thanksgiving, 2 loaves 14 Ann 10.⁰⁰
- 11 Sunday I did not go to church sent 24
- 12 Fine day not many in church, offering for Cornwall General Hospital, my off 2.⁰⁰
- 13 Cold east wind Mrs Christie here for dinner
- 14 I made jelly of the grapes - wine of the rinsing, 1 lb of butter at John's 35. Jimmie has 2 Italians digging the potatoes
- 15 Jimmie's Italians worked until 4 P.M. It rained all afternoon They put some wood into the shed and piled it Jimmie got bag of wheat 2.10 Major was thrashing in Jimmie's barn for 3 days They finished today Murdy got 2 lbs of butter at Mc Cormacks 33 pr lb

- 22 Lovely day 10
- 23 2 loaves 25
- 24 % 2 loaves 14 - 1 lb butter 35 60
- 25 Fine day but cold wind I was in church off 25 - 0 - 25 0
- 26 Cold a flurry of snow. Mrs & Miss Mc Rae Cornwall and a Mr Loney drove down to see the Cemetery, they called here and had a cup of tea with Mrs Govin in a while 3
Fine but cold. a little snow % lb tea 15 1
- 27 The ground was pretty well covered with snow this morning and it turned cold freezing all day 3
1 lb butter of 15 oz. 30 cts 2 loaves 14 44
- 28 Jimmie has an Englishman & John Panting fixing the chimneys % 3 lbs butter 32 - 96. was in morning 96
- 29 Finished the chimneys, Rain gave Mrs St-Thomas 20.⁰⁰ for two dinners to Englishman \$4.⁰⁰ John St-Thomas \$3.⁰⁰ 70
- 30 John St-Thomas. patching roof of old Post office 1/2 day 7.00
