Willie got Eaton furnace also other parcel of goods at station ^{balance} total Eaton expense (see 17th & 18th) \$38.69

Very frosty day, mostly sunny, lots of snow and drifts on rail fence roads. Willie drove Mary and I me down to church Mr Cran preached from Job 1:5

2 00 1st dance a sermon relating to the war. We gave roll \$2.00 Willie drove Bella down and we all got dinner at home Uncle Jim Auntie and Mrs Ritchie there I drove up to Jim Armstrong at night for evening. Church roll was to aid Belgians

Frosty cloudy and sunny mostly sunny. Willie drove down in morning for Mr. Anderson & Calder who came up but found new furnace had been damaged in train so they took it to station to see about getting same as it then to Matts shop where he fixed it right. Willie and I took old furnace apart before dinner. P M Willie drove down for Matt & Jim again they set up the furnace which they brought up again. Willie drove them down again in evening
