Fine sunny day warm breezy. We sowed the plowed sod No 1 W to-day Banner oats from O.S.R. O.A.C No 21 barley where oats quit $\frac{2}{3}$ over we also sowed clover. I sowed part or most of oats over again as they did not come out fast enough for the arrows, had to set it for $3\frac{3}{4}$ bushels. Agastache was got a mangrel stuck in her throat Willie drove down in evening for net but didn't get either but I drove down later brought up Mr. Fudgeon who put mangrel down then I drove him down again Cameron & Mr. Lester in A.M. looking at white stem offered \$7.35 per acre offered 5/5 for rain

Frost last night - sunny cold breezy day. We finished rolling No 1 W also harrowed it all again A.M. Willie drove down in morning took cream to Russell's also $17\frac{1}{2}$ doz eggs @ 18 to \$3.13 on c/c. Mr. Spry came about noon to see about drainage survey. P.M. Lou Sargent and Mr. Hampton came in to see if we had any horses to sell. We harrowed most of 7 L field P.M. also Willie plowed rape drills with Lucy & Punch Mary walked down to stay at home to-night.

Misty at times cloudy drizzling some at times warm & calm. We cultivated some of 7 L field W. and sowed some barley also some No 3 O.A.C oats seeding down
