- Apr. 21. Rather cloudy day.
22. Warmer but cloudy.
23. Fine. Cora and I called after tea on Mr. & Mrs. Emerson Brown. League.
24. Fine.
25. Rainy in morning. Clearing about noon. Shower and severe electrical storm about 4 to 5 P.M. Stayed here all day.
26. Cloudy with misty rain in morning. Clearing & fine. Old men's choir from Aylmer at high. Church full.
27. Cloudy in morning but clearing. Walked to Miss Shipman's.
28. Fine. Real warm.
29. Rainy or mist. Walked to Miss Suffords.
30. Colder. Cloudy. Went to Mrs. Churchill's to a trustee meeting. Hired for 1914-1915 for \$6.50.
May. 1. Fine day. Cleaned up yard and school house in afternoon. Choir practice after which I went to Mrs. Whites with Lorne.
