Bob wheeled down twice to get repairs for I & R got them at noon from Chapman got 100 ft rope for loader at Merris on c/c AM. Mary paid A. Boys \$5.00 on c/c. I got supper in field straight. Wm Clark got 2 doz eggs yesterday 50 cts
