 Tue Nov 2. Drizzling after raining all night. <sup>ingapton put in iron stove \$2.50.</sup> Mrs Langstaff called.  
 Wed Nov 3. Cold. n.w. wind I called at Willis. J. Edey. also Miss Pages called  
 took up Dahlias still not frozen. cleaned double windows.  
 Thur Nov 4. Fair but damp. Aunt M. and I in Toronto. feathers \$5.75. I called  
 to see Aunt Kate. Mabel and H. Welsh called. Rede home Nelson  
 Fri Nov 5. Fine. covered cistern. M.S. took us to Markham  
 Sat Nov 6. Fine bright day. Speights called. Mr Rewe died <sup>called at Dr 9.50</sup> Nov 3<sup>rd</sup>.  
 Sun Nov 7. Dull a few flakes. Mr Rewe buried. I went to eve church. wet  
 Mon Nov 8. Fine and bright. Mary Watson here to tea. I went to  
 Willie's in eve. P. we washed clothes drier nicely.
