(254-111)

It rained pretty much all day  
Will Crowder wife funeral was to  
day I went to Inkerman and got Jimmy  
shod 1918. It was a very heavy frost I  
went to Ottawa fair it froze the corn  
and beans we came home about 11 o'clock  
that night
