Thursday forward

Very warm day sunny 9 AM thunder shower after dinner and evening. We got spreader mended and we got 6 loads spread AM Willie finished planting 4 more rows potatoes 19 Goldwin 29212<sup>c</sup> common mostly Carman. PM we took 23 sheep up to Irvine and worked them left Jory lay at home she had 2 lambs to-day. One of the Thrushes went back to Mr. Hardy, we went for her after tea. We got 5 more loads spread after got back from Irvine. Mrs. Adams, Christy and Ritchie drove up here in PM latter staying in there at present. Mrs. Duane up in evening got some eggs to set traded for some of hers.

29

Friday

Exceedingly warm day sunny and cloudy rain heavy shower at noon. We spread 9 loads manure spreader and 3 from waggons Willie plowed some No 2 used furrow plow.

Fama had pigs to L-day Mr. Miteolf came in to escape rain at noon his umbrella blew inside out.

30

Saturday

More rain last night raining slightly all AM cleared off PM. heavy thunder shower in evening. We sorted potatoes in cellar AM. Willie plowed No 2 PM when I planted row 23 potatoes PM Mammoth Butcherly top of row 47 steps down from headland and furrows. Willie down town at night got at Nichols paint & varnish 40 Schwanke 10 can 10 meat at Mills 30 butter paper Boys 10. Put Mand out to pasture to-day with Nell & ult. Fama had 14 pigs late night.
