12 I & Henry Stover Cleaned 30 bus Peas & Threshed Spring Wheat ^{sakings}. W. very Cold. some north wind

13 I & Henry Stover finished Threshing Spring Wheat ^{sakings} & Cleaned it 4 bags wheat & a lot of Chicken feed. Then threshed a load of Peas which finishes our Threshing. W. very Cold. north wind

14 I went to Cedar Grove A.M. I took Frank to Cherry wood to be shod & Nancy went along to A.B.'s. P.M. W. Clear pretty Cold air from ^{North} Sunday 15th at home. David Harris & J.D. were here. M. Dykes little baby died this morning. ^{W. mild. Clear}

16 Chored I went to J.M. P.M. Nancy went with me to Dykes. W. very mild Clear

17 I & Adeline went to funeral of M. Dykes Child to 2^d Con. Pickering. W. Mild Cloudy. a little misty roads

18 I & Nancy went to Markham W. very ^{pretty} ^{cloudy} heavy rain this evening. roads very ^{bad}

19 Chored A.M. Went to J.M. & to David Harris P.M.

20 Took 10 bus grain Oats to Cedar Grove mills A.M. got well shod at walking P.M. W. fine Clear Uncle John Burkholder was here over night

21 Helped B.C. Co. Clean Oats A.M. brought home grain Oats P.M. W. fine Clear roads level

Sunday 22 I & Nancy went to Meeting at Cedar Grove remarks by B.C. Sermon on St. Luke 10th by R. & Barker

C.B.'s were here ^{Mar} awhile P.M. W. Clear ¹⁸⁷⁴ Squalls of snow P.M.

23 Chored. W. very high & Cold wind last night & today ^{Squalls of snow}

24 Went to Old A. Burkholder's A.M. to see for a girl for the summer. got none. I & boys Cleaned some ^{stairings} P.M. W. Clear Mild

25 I & Nancy went to Henry Stover's to see for a girl engaged One. A.M. I & John went to J. Parsons in Scarborough to engage 2 pigs @ \$2.00 apiece P.M. W. Cloudy, pretty Cold wind

26 Chored. W. some fair last night & A.M. Cleaned up P.M. very high wind tonight

27 Chored A.M. Helped B.C. Co. Clean Oats P.M.

28 I went to Cedar Grove ^{fine hard last night} A.M. Chored P.M. ^{W. fine Clear} ^{fine hard last night} ^{pretty Cold} Sunday 29th John & my Mother kept house & the rest of us went to Meeting at Debron remarks by R. Daniel Hoover Sermon on St ^{by B.C.}

30 I took Wagon to Cherry wood ^{W. fine Clear} to get tongue lengthened & Rose fixed A.M. Jos Atkinson came to Commence work at noon then he Chopped a little then we took a visit to Cedar Grove Mills. W. Clear. Cold N. wind

31 I & Nancy & little boys went to Lennox B.C. went with us to Markham station he is going to Waterloo. W. fine Clear but very Cold air from north roads pretty good. & Concession dusty this evening

April 1 I brought home Wagon from Cherry wood & Joe went to help put in logs A.M. both piled lumber P.M. W. fine pretty Clear

2 Both piled lumber A.M. drew in logs P.M. W. Cool

Good Friday 3. We my Mother & little boys went to B.C. Co. W. Cool. Clear. a very little snow last night. Keeps Cold. freezes hard every night

4 Both Piled lumber. W. very Cold from N. West. water pretty low. They cannot saw quite all the time

Sunday 5 I & Sasanna went to Meeting at Cobain J.D.'s were here today. W. Clear A.M. began to snow from East about 4 P.M. snowing yet at bedtime
