- 11 from Aunt. Got 6 from Cumming for Hay
owes Money for the rest \$14⁰⁰ coal oil 13, brod 63
- 12 Rained all day Womens meeting at C. C.
I could not go for the rain, boys took 1 load
wood
- 13 It looked like clearing up last night
but it began to rain this morning and
drizzled all day until evening then
poured, for a while, about 8 wind
blew hurricane, now 11. P. M. cold, freezing
Boy drew two loads of wood, Bird gave me 12
- 14 Boys finished drawing wood, Stormed
all day. snow drifting about I gave 10
to Far to give to Willie, and he gave
21. and got security. I read today of a snow
storm in England, that done a great
deal of harm
- 15 Cold wind, roads very slippery, out many
in church Sarah Fraser (Fred Hays house, Kap)
did this morning at her sister Mrs. Christolm
house, on Warren Street
- 16 Bright day, Wind cold roads very slippery
- 17 St. Patrick's day, Fine and bright
- 18 Shela's day, she must be angry at Patrick
for she snowed & stormed all day
- 19 Got 1 lb tea 45, I was out at Prayer meeting
- 20 Thursday Fine day
- 21 Pigeon shovemaker took a job of sawing 12
loads of wood for us, and got J. Grant
this afternoon with his machine, and
cut it all, It rained all afternoon
sold 2 doz eggs at Willie's 18cts for doz
got molasses, got 3 1/2 lb brown sugar 25 25
5 lb rice 25cts, at J. A. S 1/2 lb raisins 15 40
got 25 from Aunt
