Vomiting in Infancy.

Dr. J. Sébilleau, in Revue Pratique d'Obstét, Paris, describes the different causes for habitual vomiting in a nursling, stating that treatment can be only tentative first until it is learned whether overfeeding or underfeeding is responsible for the vomiting or other causes are involved. He has found very valuable a tablespoonful of a 1.7 per cent. solution of sodium citrate added to each feeding or given the child before it is put to the breast.
