To Estimate the Solids in Urine.

In order to estimate the number of grains of solids passed each two hours, measure accurately the number of ounces of urine passed during this period, record same and estimate by Haines's modification of Haser's rule. Multiply the last two figures of the specific gravity of the urine by number of ounces voided in twenty-four hours, and add 10 per cent. to the product.—*Med. Summary.*
