

Wednesday February 9th

I saw Sid Marsh at the Charlie Munroe place when we came by so as soon as we got the horses put away I went over but he had gone so I took a look over the buildings. Most of them need considerable repair. It was by this time getting quite late so there was not much after noon left by the time I had dinner. I didn't do much but chores and clean out the colony house. Mr. & Mrs. Cornish were in for awhile this afternoon. Another fine day mild and muddy.

Thursday February 10th

I made a sheep trough this morning to feed them their grain. I saw Sid Marsh over in the woods so I went over to interview him. He came down in his price to forty one hundred for the place so I told him I would see

Dad. and let him know this afternoon. This afternoon Mary, Harry B. and I drove down town and left the other two with Ina. We called in at the farm and found the whole family there assembled. Dad. thought Marsh's price was not too high so I drove back out here again and told him I would take the place. We left Harry B. at the farm and I drove Mary up to see Mrs. Cam. M^r. Bride while I came out here. Mrs. Cam is in bad shape. She fell a week or so ago and cut her leg and it is not healing well at all. We called at the farm & got Harry B. on our way home, and I drove Ina home before tea. To night I went over to Willie Shand's to figure money debate to-morrow night. but we didn't do much. They told me over there that Tom Stone is having a dance to-morrow night, which looks like a mean stroke of business. Ina never mentioned it to Mary but when Mary asked her if she had her horse ready for the social, she said "No. I tell the truth I don't think I'll go." Sunny but cold wind.

Friday February 11th

We were very late getting around this morning. I didn't finish milking till after tea. Harry B. and I took the cream to the carrier and then went over
