Lewis children here ^{got the Potatoes 9 of them} Leander crossed to Summerstown Wild Geese

about 12 to Day Fixing Barrels took Big Pans to the Camp took Ten
Pans to camp 2nd a very Fine Warm Day about 290 Tapt now
3rd Raining Snowing Rained hard to night 1 of the Cows calved
