

Saturday April 1, 1922

Kent went down to see about the mail but no mail came.

The storm put the Hydros out of order and the telephones are all out.

In the afternoon Kent went to W.C. Gordon's and got 23 bush and 30 lbs of oats at 40 cents a bush \$9.56

The day was fine and the frost cleared off the trees.

Sunday April 2, 1922

I walked up to Church in the morning. There were no cars running and the telephone was off.

The day was very fine.

Monday April 3, 1922

Kent delivered mail to the Bay and round the townline with Lloyd and George to the Bay and round the townline with Susan.

I delivered on the Club point with Dick.

We had three days mail as the cars didn't run on Friday and Saturday. The greater part of the day was fine but it sprinkled rain in the evening.
