 Monday 21st Sandy & Antwine I went to
 In Iniqua River the Harrowing the Fall was
 for the first Harrowing cutting the Butternut
 tree and the cherry that fell with the corner
 Bought of P Buchanan 66 cent for 100 Poles
 6 Rounds + 100 Poles gave a Dollar gave back
 the change 2 Bushel salt charged to me
 22nd Thrashing Big Rease 23rd Fanning the Big Rease
 3 Bushels Sandy went to Williamstown 1 Day
 of Autumn 24th Making stack of Hay
 Began to Milk 26th Raffle of Rob Summers
 of a Cow 25th Began the Chimney Antwine
 Thrashing the Small Rease 26th Fanning
 the Chimney 27th Sunday Antwine & Sandy
 went to Rosses Island for nuts sandy went
 home with Ellen 28th Fanning the Rease
 7 Bushels Put a Board on the calve Sancy
 Ploughing Lashy here Found a cow that
 was skinned took her ashore 29th Ploughing
 shot a Duck & A Kuster took the Yellow
 out of the cow Antwine at the Ashes
 Set Michael Wild Geese Plenty 30th Last of the
 Month helping Antwine with the Logging put
 2 Loads on the stack ploughing October 1st
 finished the Marsh Stack 60 or 70 coils in it
 stacked the straw ploughing set 4 in the
 swamp taking in Butternuts 2nd Antwine
 underpinning the house Banking some Sancy
 Ploughing in the upper field 3rd Went to Salmon
 with Ashes 4th a Buck lot 50 cents Antwine 5 cent
 Bought of Norman 1 Bottle 1/3 on credit Tobacco
 (5 cents paid) Bought of Baker 1/2 line 1/2 paid Bought
 of Buchanan 1/2 18 cents

Mr James Cameron Island Oct 4th
 Sunday John Angus here in the Bush at nuts
 5th all the Spokes Antwine and me ploughing
 Sancy ploughing 6th Splitting spokes Sancy
 Sunday salted 9 Dozen of Eggs put them
 in the Cellar
 7th Tom came with the Line Antwine and
 me to the Hot Pit got a Bull alive caught
 4 perch Tom left his papers and hope
 8th Sancy & Antwine went to Summers took
 an awful spree had a Bottle could
 not find it Sancy took a 1/4 of Tea got some
 Money from a Cameron Shelling Corn
 me 9th Looking for the Bottle I found
 it all watered Plastering some set the Line
 10th Our Neighbors Birth Day Antwine
 went for a Quart to Wenshaws Plastering
 11th Sunday went to Harpers and then to
 Salmon River one of the Traders women
 departed about this time Lorna Gordon
 I to the Bush for Beech nuts 12th Put
 in the Stack of Hay alone they came stinging
 they went to christies for Sheeps for David
 Summers slept all night the old man both
 stinging shot a Mud Hen 13th Working at the
 House old Man came had christies canoe
 Banking the House shot 2 Ducks did not get
 them 14th Went to a Summers to settle
 £1 9⁰⁰ gave my Note to him Bought
 5 cent worth of sugar went to see Mr Harper
 about the wood Sancy & Antwine to christies
 for 2 Sticks brought them Found 6 pieces
 went over with 2 of them Antwine went off to
 christies Sancy slept all night at Summers
 of wood
