Hard frost last night fine sunny day. I plowed No 5 AM. Willie took cream down in morning got bread 7 cts 6 cts bolts for mower Chapmans 20 cts meat at Russell's on of 90 cts. he cut clover in No 7 till noon. P.M. we fixed rake and I raked clover No 7 Willie finished cutting it. We brought over a load.

Thursday

Frost last night again fine sunny gradually clouded over. Muzzled and rained a few drops. Willie put 18 lbs gross gasoline in engine chopped horse. I put harness together harnessed some of No 5 then we both went to hayfield No 7 raked and waled. PM we raked and waled again and brought over small load. Father walked off AM went down with girls PM they went to Russell's milking opening got bet it made. Mr Bonham over in evening to get some
