Fine cool sunny day rain and cloudy in early morning. Willie plowed all day in No 2 sod. I went down helped Father take down part of stable and put end on what was left. Then took 19 bags up to D. Allans for oats and paid him \$5.00 on them

Fine cool sunny day. Willie plowed No 2 sod. I scuffed mangols and turnips. Many down town in PM drove Father down who came up to see Willie about getting the rate of proposed debentures of + eggs for Yew spun line) she got at Armstrongs groceries \$1.13 at Russells on a/c dry goods 64cts. We weaned lambs today took 17 sheep down home and left 2 & lambs and one sheep off. We gave Father \$10.00 \$16.50 to pay Mrs Moffatt for parlor window seat and \$3.50 to go on insurance. cream 7<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> tot 130

Fine sunny day. I drove Bella and Willie to station S 711 to go to Toronto Exhibition in morning. In PM I brought down 5 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> bushels Siquava oats from D. Allans then went for another load 20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> bushels Siquava oats and 16 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> bushels barley took latter load to Wilsons Mill to get chopped for pig feed. Brought up load manure from Smalls. Paid D. Allan on a/c of oats \$20.00
