

W. James Cameron Island 1st June 1871
The glorious first of June fixing the fence on the
Pitt Point the Dick most awful Bad very warm day
Taking home Wood cutting the Weeds in the Potatoes
in the Bush. Planted 2 Rows of Garrot chilies
above the currant Bushes cutting Weeds in the
hilled some of them Grubs very Bad cutting Onions
and Potatoes the Hen commenced to lay again
Put the Bell on the heifer Looking at the
Sugar it Beginning to crack Nowling commenced
3rd Went down to the Pitt with Gordon Hanstolp
and myself got a Chub and Perch very stormy for
a little while fine cutting the Weeds in the back
garden seen Henry Fishing Perch 4th June
Old George the 3rd Birds Birth Day Trinity
Sunday Nowling Randolph Gordon and I
wife here yesterday with fish to sell found
2 nests one with 6 Eggs the other with 9 a very very warm
warm hot sun to day 5th Cropped to Summerstown got
the carrot seed Mr Beley left at Thomas allumous
where Jim Roy putting a lot of cattle on the boat
British Columbia 6th Brought some cherry Bark
over for Mr Baker Brought a cake of sugar to Peter
and Brought it home would not sell it for 50 cents
Thomas fixing his Boat Bought of A. I. Baker 2nd lb
helping George Kershaw to put out his scow McCreig
putting his horses down to Francis Island
Big John Grant departed this life

W. James Cameron Island June 7th 1871
Very Windy Fixing my ashes in Bags
to go to Dunblair Gyles Linc. col. here and 4
more men in his cedar Boat had 5 casks of stuff
got some stuff he had in a Bottle from him they
started found a Birch Log drove in to shore 8th Went
to Bosells Gordon and for a canoe got the Loan of
10 lb of Flour from Mrs M. G. In tosh at archy
Big John Grant up the front Burred to day
Go Laplante and wife at Bosells Henry Bosell got a
large Washenorge to day high Wind Gordon and coming
home 2 Ellen wind Bohind on the Pitt Point Coyett
and son slept in the Barn all night got some
salt to salt their fish 9th Bosell Marys Birth
Day wind high caught some perch Brought home
the Birch saw Log started for salmon Near Gordon
and as the Wind is down a little 8 Bushels of
5 lb of iron 12 lb of Bags 12 1/2 lb of sugar
at old Maryvilles Gordon and Maryvilles girl
sick the Doctor there 10th started up to the
store from Maryvilles forgot about 16 lb of iron
left it on the shore took Breakfast Gordon and
Donato Mr Jonell Supple Bought of Robert Baker
2 Dollars of Flour 3 lb got it at a hats 1/2 lb Job 1/2 lb Sea Mate
got 25 cents for 40 lb of iron 3 cents for Cotton Bags 20 cents for Ashes 10 cents for
sugar got 2 fallons of soft soap from Mr Baker became down with
to the Maryville farm catching his horses sailed home the Adolphus
went up to day for to take the Dunblair folk to procession to Williamstown
with Bosells canoe got a Bottle of Milk from Georges wife had Mrs Macintosh
the flour - got from her Mr Baker taking down a Raft of Paul to the Farm
