went floating Down Past water
some high Got a Letter from the
Glenarrigan wanting 2 Dollars to go
Chinia not well 25th Raining Cutting some
Levers here got the Flarrow a Boat again
at the Light House Hamilton together off
Mixing Paint for to paint the Boat Soley
Boats going Seander to Summersdown to night
Crimma to Bed to Day 26th Fine & Wind
Heard Lizzie Hamilton departed
yesterday in Montreal Mrs Saerd
John went Down to Day 2 Indians
one Peter Tree for ash Sent a Letter to
Maie Wilson with 2 Dollars in it
