- 5 went to Yananogue to the Fair - acted as Judge
 on Sheep bags & putting fine day
- 6 dug some potatoes very dry time
- 7 I & J. Stace came & left his machine
- 8 no meeting here Geordy & the girls went to the Church
 at night heard the Rev. Mr. Jones
- 9 thrashed our grain had 23 bushel of peas 45
 of wheat 12 of barley 152 of oats & cornet Wm
 cornet J. Mc Mullin Wm J. Turner Thomas Bradley
 Thurophing Young Capland helped
- 10 cleared up the floor & put in part of the straw
 in the forenoon. Geordy drew 120 bushel of sand
 for Jb McKay in the afternoon & little room at night
- 11 put in the remainder of the straw & drew in
 the corn stalks mixed straw with the stalks
- 12 heavy rain all night & this morning a fine
 day for our fair ^{afterwards} attended it took the first
 on the sporting bull 2nd on 2 Ewes
- 13 dug some of the potatoes fine day
- 14 Geordy went to Yananogue with 10 bushel of wheat
 Ellen & Isabella went with him intending to Mr. Starks
 & get a yarn he was to bring it from King's ton
 they brought home the yarn
- 15 Mr. Beere & Mr. Robertson preached in the evening
- 16 dug some of the potatoes Geordy has took
 a notice to go to Red River he is going -
 round amongst the neighbors Mr. Rose the
 Galport here all night
