of phosphate in it then drilled it up 12 drills.
Willie and Peter Clark took the 12 sheep
& 12 lambs up to Irvine and washed them
I cultivated scuffled mangel with Mand and
Willie sowed the 12 drills turnip Good Luck with
Punch after they came home from washing sheep
Peter Clark clipped dead sheep we buried it
in orchard after tea. We paid Peter 1.10 in fuel
Messrs Day and son also Mr Craig came in
evening with draining medicine. Willie got
at Bergins in morning meat \$1.05.
