Field 29<sup>th</sup> Unfortunate Day Rained  
West Wind Boiling syrup 30<sup>th</sup> Fine  
froze some last night Sap Runners  
some to Day went up around the  
South side Found Tibble laid  
out up in the Bay sent 2 Papers  
to John Cameron Junction City Renshaw  
seander to Summerstown Put in the  
Dig in this Place Letting the Water  
Run in different Places Got the  
Parcel 2 Parasols for Mel  
from Dan a Letter too 31<sup>st</sup> Fine  
Last Day of March a very fine March  
from the first to the last Set  
fire at the Lower Point a calf to Day  
1<sup>st</sup> of April Unfortunate Day Fine  
all in fools Day Windy Cool froze  
at nights in the sugar Bush heads  
Mr Donald Mr Sittles Departed  
on the 31<sup>st</sup> of March at Meadow 13
