Appendicitis is sometimes mistaken for typhoid fever. A careful physical examination, and, if need be, an operation will decide the question, for it is better to remove a normal appendix than to mistake a diseased appendix for typhoid fever. In appendicitis no time should be wasted by laborious blood examinations.—Rueck; Med. Record.
