26 Thursday. Fine warm day. Walter shepped hogs this morning. They finished haying and brought in the last 5 loads, making a total of 48 loads of hay. Sam Horst helped and he got the last two loads. Tonight, Ella visited Mrs. Louis Miller while the men went <sup>to</sup> Dave Kotts.
