 S.M. Kee, R. Black, Mr Boys for Magwood.

16 Wednesday  
 Misty morning cleared off fine day hay sunny.  
 Mr Lunn out from 10 o'clock we pulled and trimmed  
 turnips. Willie at Skeochs thrashing A.M. hauled two  
 loads turnips down in P.M. about 162 bushels

17 Thursday  
 Fine day sunny and cloudy warm. Mr Lunn  
 over from 8:20 to 4 P.M. we trimmed  
 turnips. Willie got two loads down in A.M. and  
 one in P.M. had to wait till after six o'clock to get  
 it off they had not a car ready before. Willie got  
 tickets 5 loads 50 cts got chgs for 410 bushels @ 12 cts last load 115  
 \$48.40 got Prince chd at Hodge n fcs. Girls over  
 at Mrs Wm Hamilton in P.M.
