- Thurs May 19. Fine and much warmer. Aunt Mattie and I in Toronto Mr and Mrs Atkinson called to say good-bye.
- Fri May 20. Fine and very warm. Aunt Nellie at M Watsons in eve.
- Sat May 21. Fine and extremely warm. terrific dust. Cyril cut grass. 35 cents.
- Sun May 22. Fair at first then came heavy rain about noon. I went to morning Church. "Christening, rain will do good as ground very dry and baked. Aunt Mattie. Mrs Davidson and I. at church. Thunder storm as we came from church.
